SPORTS ARENA

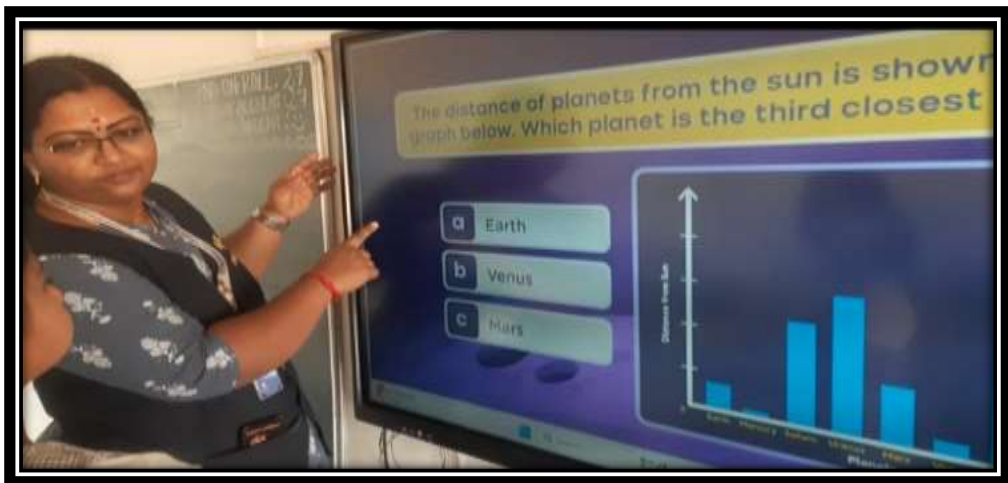
